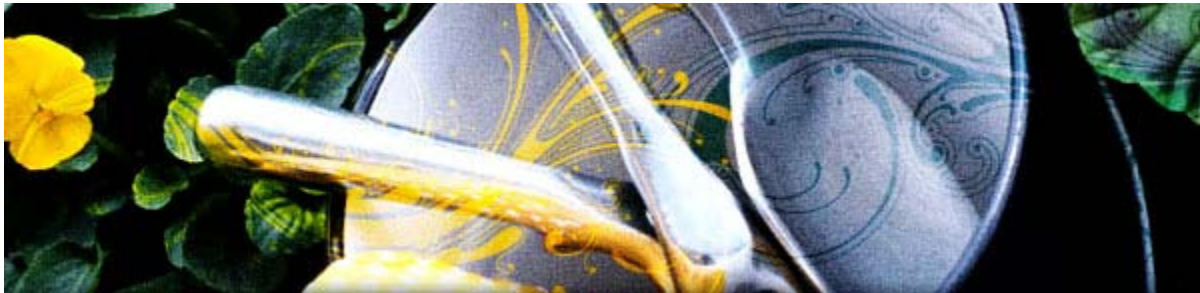

Outdoor watering now allowed in Cobb

Cobb County officials have eased guidelines for outdoor watering. Hand watering, defined as one person with one hose with a shut-off nozzle, will be allowed for 25 minutes a day, on the odd/even watering schedule. Even and unnumbered addresses may water Mondays, Wednesdays and Saturdays and odd addresses may water on Tuesdays, Thursdays and Sundays between the hours of 4 and 9 a.m. Effective April 1, 2008, an exemption is provided for new landscape installations. They may be watered for a period of 10 weeks following installation on the odd/even watering schedule. Irrigation systems may be used to water newly - installed landscaping, only between the hours of 4:00 AM and 9:00 AM.
